O R D E R

CRLMP 2947 of 2017 has been filed on behalf of the  
petitioner/applicant for grant of stay.

This Court vide order dated September 9, 2013, referred  
Criminal Appeal Nos.1375-1376 of 2013 and other connected matters  
involving similar question of law to a larger Bench as it observed  
that there was difference of opinion amongst different Benches of

this Court, as well as all the High Courts. It is not in dispute that in all those cases this Court has granted stay of further proceedings of the cases pending before the trial court. This matter has been tagged with Criminal Appeal Nos.1375-1376 of 2013 and other connected matters. However, no stay has been granted in this case. Therefore, the petitioner has filed an application, being CRLMP 2947 of 2017 seeking stay of the trial court proceedings initiated by the RC No.14(E)/2005/EOW/DLI dated 30.9.2005.

As stated above, in all the connected matters this Court has granted stay of further proceedings pending before the trial court. After hearing learned senior counsel for the parties, we think similar order needs to be passed in this case as well. There shall be an order of stay before the trial court until further orders.

Hence the criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and disposed of accordingly.
